Principal's Report-Lara Krill (see attached report)

Review mission statement and how we can bring it to life.

**Enrollment:** Discuss ways to reach new populations

- Pre-K is up 22.2%
- Good retention rate from Pre-K to K.
- 19 families transferred out and Kathy tracked why they left: 5 moved out of state, 4 moved back down to Junior K, 2 moved to different part of Louisville and St. G was not convenient, other unknown.
- Jennifer and Kathy tracking information after family do tours to see what they are looking for in a school.

### Marketing:

- Miranda suggests updating teacher profiles on website prior to announcement of teachers/classes.
- Joe Raymond created the staff directory, and it is usually updated in October once staff pics have been taken.
- Social media intern is being considered to help with this
- Suggested to have teachers control some of the posts in their classrooms so uploads can be more frequent
- Cross reference posts with all St. Gabriel pages (i.e., Sports ministry shares school posts and school shares parish posts etc.)
- Have the staff like the posts and share as well. This will improve visibility across social media platforms. Could
  even have a special giveaway (amazon gift card) to encourage staff to like the posts. The staff "caught"
  liking/sharing post will win the incentive

- Encourage parents in the trumpet to like and follow all pages as well
- Kate also suggests highlighting teachers (and maybe even students) on social media.
- Positive reviews on social media. Can send links to families to leave reviews of St. Gabriel
- Tina suggests targeting parish members with school age children to determine whey they don't attend St. Gabriel
- Do we still reach out to families after child has been baptized?

### **Covid update:**

- Guidance changes daily
- Similar to last school year
- · Vaccinations are not required, but highly encouraged
- Also cannot require showing vaccine card, but request for quarantine purposes
- Large plastic barriers likely will not be needed this year
- Smaller table barriers may still be needed in rooms with larger class size
- Desks need to be 3 ft apart
- K-2 lunch will be delivered to classrooms
- 3-8 will go to cafeteria and take to classroom or outside
- Recess will be in the back of campus
- RLO will not be offered at St. Gabriel, partnering with Catholic Virtual through archdiocese to offer this option
- Families must commit to a full semester and still pay St. Gabriel tuition
- RLO will not be offered for a student in quarantine, but make-up work will be provided
- Questions about who provides guidance for quarantine; Laura Krill voices that that is the Health Departments role

### Technology:

Cameras in the sanctuary now and St. Gabriel has a YouTube channel to watch stream

### Staff:

- Concerns voiced regarding staffing
- Still in need of 1 teacher and 4 assistants for this school year
- Questions regarding salary of Gabriel teacher vs public school teacher (\$20,000 difference)
- Are exit interviews conducted when teachers leave to determine plan to retain
- Creating incentives for teachers: teacher pins at first staff meeting and then every five years
- Create feeling of loyalty
- Teacher shout out boxes
- Covid has affected staff retention
- Spotlight teachers and their experience
- St. Gabriel has a strong staff, want to retain and make them feel appreciated
- Cannot change salary as it is archdiocese based
- Compensate them in other ways, recognize that teachers are called to this vocation

### Other:

• There is a new member school board training at Archdiocese in September, but no official date announced yet.

#### Fr. Jason:

Enrollment feeds into all aspects of the parish and school. It's an important piece of the parish community as a whole.
